GIRL  
You remembered!

Shop Owner shrugs and motions it's no big deal.

SHOP OWNER  
(To Date, blandly) And you?

DATE  
Nah, no thanks.

Shop Owner purses his lips, then moves to the register. The Date is prompted by the Girl to pay.

The couple sits in the corner, the Girl forcing conversation.

Shop Owner continues scooping, always watching the Girl.

As the Date continues to be rude, the Shop Owner gets angrier.

The Date gets up abruptly, SQUEAKING the chair, leaving the Girl, letting the door SLAM behind him.

INT. ICE CREAM SHOP - EVENING

She smiles as she leaves the shop, and he waves goodbye too big. She GIGGLES as she finally exits. Shop Owner lovingly watches her leave.

When he looks back at the table, he sees her journal laying on the table.

He grabs it and bolts outside after her.

EXT. SIDEWALK - EVENING

He runs to the RIGHT, following her, but realizes she is already gone. He places his hands on top of his head, BREATHING HARD.

He turns back to the shop defeated.

EXT. STREET - ACROSS FROM ICE CREAM SHOP - EVENING

Shop Owner walks back inside shop. The ice cream shop is located beside a journal shop, where we see the Girl searching for her journal. The Shop Owner is unaware of her proximity.

INT. ICE CREAM SHOP - EVENING

The Shop Owner flips sign on door to closed, DROPS journal on the counter by the register.

He begins cleaning already clean counters, restocking waffle cones, refilling topping containers, waiting for her.

INT. ICE CREAM SHOP - NIGHT

He sits behind the counter on a stool, reading, eyeing the journal.

He shakes his head, knowing he should not open it.

He eyes it, looks away again, then finally concedes.

He picks up the journal, checks around to make sure no one sees even in his empty shop, and flips through the pages.

INT. ICE CREAM SHOP - JOURNAL - NIGHT

Inside are several drawings of his ice cream shop, some with him working, some of the customers, then towards the end a picture of just him, watching unknown someone lovingly from the counter.

INT. ICE CREAM SHOP - NIGHT

Shop Owner looks up stunned, amazed that she actually noticed him.

He flips to the next blank page, and begins drawing.

INT. ICE CREAM SHOP - DAY

Shop Owner asleep at counter, on top of closed journal.

A KNOCK on the door.

He awakens slowly, stretching and rubbing the sleep out of his eyes.

Girl waves at him as he looks up.

He grabs her journal and walks to the door to let her in.

SHOP OWNER

Is this what you're looking for?

He hands her the journal.

(CONTINUED)

GIRL  
Yeah, thanks! I can't believe  
you're still here.

SHOP OWNER  
Well, I figured it was really  
important.

GIRL  
Thank you, so much. It means a lot.  
I'll see you around!

He waves bye as she leaves, disappointed.

He begins setting up for the day, taking chairs off tables.

EXT. SIDEWALK - DAY

Girl notices a dog-eared page in her journal, pauses on  
sidewalk to look, confused.

A smile spreads across her face when she opens journal.

She turns around and runs back.

INT. ICE CREAM SHOP - DAY

The BELL DINGS, and the Girl runs to the boy, kisses him.

SHOP OWNER

an artist...

Girl laughs, and reopens the journal.

INT. ICE CREAM SHOP - JOURNAL - DAY

A basic stick figure drawing of two people, one holding an  
ice cream cone, the other a journal, holding hands. They are  
dressed for a wedding.

INT. ICE CREAM SHOP - DAY

Still on picture, ZOOM OUT to show it is now framed and  
hanging in the ice cream shop.

The Girl and the Shop Owner are working together, happy and  
laughing.

She kisses his cheek.

The ice cream shop is buzzing.

FADE OUT.
